Its purpose, as stated in this certificate, was "To provide a center of religious worship of the Jewish faith and such other charitable, religious and other activities required or appropriate therewith." On September 17, 1974, Temple Beth Torah held its first High Holiday services in our present building. This summer, our congregation will be leaving this home of the past 36 years and moving into a brand new building right down the street from our present location.
